

Education Property Tax Credit

The Education Property Tax Credit is a credit for Manitoba homeowners and tenants. Property owners may have the credit directly applied to their municipal property tax statements. The Education Property Tax Credit can only be claimed on a homeowner's principal residence up to a maximum of \$700. Applications received by April 1st will be added to the current tax year.

Checklist (check all that apply):

- This property is designated as your principal residence.
- This property is assessed as a single residential dwelling unit (Resident 1).
If the property is not a single residential dwelling unit, the Education Property Tax Credit Advance cannot be granted on the property tax statement. You will need to apply for the credit on your income tax return.
- The mailing address on the property tax statement is correct.
- I am not receiving a credit on any other home within Manitoba.
